

## ELIZABETH STONE FUND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Elizabeth Stone Fund scholarships are one-time awards intended to be used for expenses associated with freshman year at an accredited four-year institution of higher learning. The Elizabeth Stone Fund was formed with a bequest from the estate of Elizabeth Stone for the purpose of establishing a scholarship fund for deserving high school graduates. This year, as many as four scholarships of at least \$1,000 may be awarded.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

The applicant must be a Jamestown resident who has been accepted at an accredited four-year institution of higher learning. He or she must be a graduating senior at an accredited public, private, parochial, vocational or charter high school; or be completing a home school program approved by the Jamestown School Committee. Preference may be given to students accepted at Rhode Island School of Design or a similar four-year fine arts institution; such applicants are welcome to submit copies of student work with their application.
